GEM - We want you to continue to practice GEM (Gratitude, Empathy and Mindfulness) especially during isolation. Refer to Google Classrooms in the Classwork section, under Personal Learning for each day's daily prompt. We want you to get creative with your responses though. You might like to present your answer as a short video, or a drawing or you might like to write a short story about a fictional character to show your answer. You get to be creative!
