

Remote Learning - Year 1 - Week 5

You will need:

- A blank sheet of paper
- Food dye (if you don't have any that's ok just use textas)
- Water
- A paint brush
- A black pen

For this activity we are going to use food colouring and water as paint to make some colourful snails!

Below are the written instructions if you need them:

- Put a small amount of water into a cup and add a few drops of food colouring (if you have more than one colour you can add this to a different cup of water)
- On a blank piece of paper tip your paint brush into the coloured water and paint a spiral shape onto your paper - like the image below



- If you have a second colour you can overlap these onto this spiral - your colours may run together a bit which makes a very cool effect!
- Leave your snail to dry and then using your black pen you can draw in its body, antennas and face!

** if you don't have food dye you can use textas to draw a colourful spiral and then paint water over the top - it will turn the textas into a painted effect!

Below is a finished snail picture - this one has two snails and I've added in a garden!
