Landscape Reflections

You will need:

- Blank piece of paper
- Greylead pencil
- Textas
- A paint brush
- A glass of water

Instructions:

Step 1 - fold your piece of paper in half like the picture below and then open it out

Step 2 - on the top half of your paper draw a line a few centimeters above the folded line - this will be your river.

Step 3 - on the top half of your paper only- sketch in some tall trees and some shorter trees Step 4 - Using textas colour in your trees and the river - make sure you colour slowly and carefully

Step 5 - Using your paint brush, brush water onto the bottom half of your page

Step 6 - Re-fold your paper so that the wet side is pressed into the dry side

Step 7 - Unfold your paper to reveal your reflection!
