

## Remote Learning - Year 2 - Week 5

You will need:

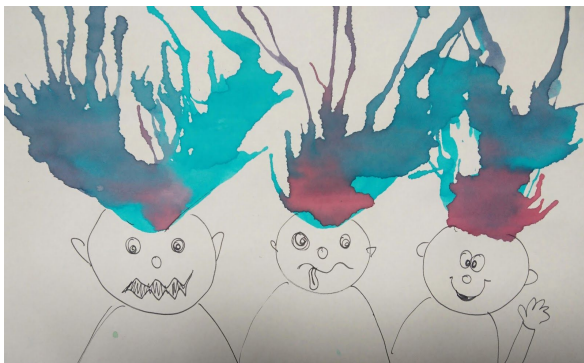
- A blank sheet of paper
- A straw (preferably but ok if you don't have one)
- Food dye (preferably but ok if you don't have any - you will just use textas)
- Water
- Black pen

For this task we are going to create some crazy haired people! Watch the below learning video for instructions on how to do this.

Here are the written instructions also -

- Add a few drops of food dye to a cup of water - this will make very runny paint.
- If you have more than one colour you can add these to a different cup of water.
- Remember that if you mix two primary colours together you will get a secondary colour (red + blue = purple, red + yellow = orange, blue + yellow = green)
- On your blank page place a few drops of your paint onto your paper.
- Using your straw gently blow the paint so that it moves across your page.
- Add a few more drops and repeat until you have many coloured squiggles on your page.
- Let your paint dry completely
- Using your black pen draw a face underneath your colours making it appear to have crazy hair.
- Below is a finished example to help you.



\*\* If you don't have food dye try using textas to make some random squiggly lines in different colours then paint water over the top to turn your texta marks into 'paint'. You can then draw your faces onto your page when it's dry.
