DPS Year 4-6 Managed Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Program for 2021

Dear Parents,

In 2021 Drysdale Primary School (DPS) will be continuing to offer a Managed Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Program to students in Year 4-Year 6. Once a device is purchased via our managed program, DPS will offer technical (hardware/software) support for this device until the end of Year 6.

To assist you with costs we have made available three different devices for you to choose from. DPS sources a preferred supplier, (JB Hi Fi) based on best cost at the time of negotiation. It is important to note that DPS does not receive any incentives when parents use the preferred supplier – we simply believe that it is the best deal for parents at the time of launching our BYOD program. Full hardware and software support will be available if you choose to purchase through the JB Hi Fi portal.

You may source one of the **approved models** yourself from another provider (see overleaf for models and specifications). Please be aware that if you choose this method, you will be solely responsible for any hardware issues that may arise (e.g. warranty claims). Please pay attention to the details and **ensure that the specifications are exactly as listed. DPS cannot accept any other device into its managed BYOD program.** We will offer software support only to this method of purchase.

Please Note: All devices come with a 3 year warranty. However, you if wish, in addition you can purchase **3 Year Onsite Accidental Damage Protection insurance (\$110)**

This covers accidental damage not covered by the warranty.

It is intended that this device will be used through until the end of a student's primary schooling. Therefore, an insurance plan covering 3 years would be ideal.

Please note: We are only given short notice if/when the manufacturer updates pricing

Things to look out for from previous BYOD programs:

- Please note: For any early purchases prior to 2021, please be aware that the warranty is for 3 years from the date of delivery. E.g. If delivered in Term 4 in Year 3, warranty will expire Term 4 year 6.
- Accidental damage is not covered under warranty. This includes screens.
- Accidental damage repairs without insurance will need to be organised and sourced by the owners of the device, outside of the school.
- Touch screens are expensive to repair if you do not have insurance. Accidental damage to screens is not covered under warranty. Although there have only been a few broken screens in 2020, the ones that had touchscreens and no insurance were costly to repair. Please consider if you need the device to be a touch screen.
- **The Lenovo 300e** (first option) has a soldered on hard drive. If the computers mainboard needs to be replaced under warranty, data on the drive cannot be backed up as the drive is not detachable. Therefore, it is encouraged to always backup your computer. Students should store important school work on their schools network drive, where it is backed up by the school. We had a few of these fixed under warranty this year, and data couldn't be backed up once the computer had stopped working and was logged for repair. No matter the type of computer chosen, it is always a good idea to back up regularly.
